## City of New Haven Health Department Itinerant Vendor Licensing

Apply for a Food Service License on <u>City Squared</u>

A copy of a proposed menu and Certified Food Protection Manager certification (if applicable) must be uploaded to the application.



If you do not have a Certified Food Protection
Manager Certification you can get a certificate
from a State of CT approved testing
organization. State of Connecticut approved

Protection Manager Certification



Upload a copy of your current vending permit or a receipt of payment for a vending permit with your application. This permit applicant must be the same as the Certified Food Protection Manager!

If you have not applied for a vending permit, please contact the <u>City of New Haven Office of Building Inspection and Enforcement.</u>



Contact the <u>City of New Haven Fire</u> <u>Marshal's Office</u> for a fire compliance inspection for approval. An electronic sign off will be provided once your application is approved.



Once the application is complete, all documents are received, and the Fire Marshal sign off (if applicable) call the City of New Haven Health Department at 203-946-8174 to schedule an inspection to license the food truck/cart.
